



Bridges

A dental bridge is used to replace one or more missing teeth. It is cemented in place using the two adjacent teeth as support for the replacement tooth.

The result effectively 'bridges the gap'. Bridges are suitable if you are able to maintain a high level of oral hygiene and commit to regular dental examinations and hygiene visits. They can be fabricated with a number of different materials and their application can be customised to suit your situation.

The treatment process involves a detailed preparation appointment where specific information is collected and impressions are recorded. Once your bridge has been designed, we will check how it fits and then fix this in place using dental cement. This tooth replacement option is carefully colour matched to your existing teeth and your new tooth can go unnoticed to even the trained eye.
